School Board Selects New Superintendent

Since the middle of February, the Continental Board of Education has been going through the process of trying to select the next superintendent for the district. The Board decided to form a committee of people to go through this process with. The committee included all school board members; representatives from the Continental Local Education Association; Elementary Principal Tracy Potts; Dean of Students, Tim Eding; and the Treasurer, Kathleen Schmitz.

The group began by meeting to determine what they were looking for in the next superintendent and then started reviewing resumes. From the 21 applicants for

the position, the committee chose six candidates to interview. After the initial round of interviews, the committee narrowed the list to three candidates to participate in a second round of interviews. After selecting their top candidate and conducting a site tour, Mr. Danny Kissell was identified and named by the school board as the next superintendent at a special board meeting on April 27th.

Mr. Kissell has been serving the last couple of years as the elementary principal with Gibsonburg Schools. Prior to that, he served as the middle and high school principals with Gibsonburg, and has been with the

district since 2002. Mr. Kissell has also been with Swanton Schools as junior high principal and special education director. His teaching experience comes as having been a special education teacher with Benton Carrol Salem Schools in Oak Harbor and a multiple handicap teacher with Ashland City Schools.

Bowling Green State University is where he received his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees. Mr. Kissell received his superintendent's license through the University of Findlay.

A father of three boys, the youngest of which will be a

high school junior, Mr. Kissell is also married to a teacher. His wife, Tammy, teaches first grade at Woodmore Schools, just north of Gibsonburg.

Mr. Kissell officially takes over on August 1st, but he will be around the district this summer working with Mr. Mengerink and getting to know people in the community. Mr. Mengerink's last day on the job will be July 31st.




Thank you to all of the emergency personnel that participated in this exercise. It was a touching, and hopefully, learning experience for all students involved.






